PRESBYTERY NEWS

Induction Services

Here is another reminder of two induction services coming up in the next few days.

Canterbury Balwyn Road will celebrate the induction of Rev Salesi Faupula on **Sunday 18th March at 2.30pm** at their church on the corner of Balwyn Road and Erica Street, Balwyn.

Presbytery Resourcing

A lively discussion at the recent meeting of the Presbytery made some important decisions about the future staffing of the Presbytery. The Presbytery gave approval in principle for a presbytery staffing model based on at least three full-time (or equivalent) Presbytery Minister positions as a basis for future planning by the Standing Committee. The Standing Committee was directed to proceed as quickly as possible to appoint a task group to prepare a Placement Profile for Presbytery Ministers in the Presbytery of Yarra Yarra which recognises the particular need in this

Presbytery for intercultural and missional support, and based as far as possible on a general description of the following broad areas of presbytery activity:

- Working with congregations, agencies and institutions;
- Working with ministry agents; and
- Working with administration, finance and property to support both congregations and ministers.

The Standing Committee will be starting to address these issues at its meeting this week.

The 15th Triennial Assembly Meeting will be held at Box Hill Town Hall, Melbourne from Sunday 8 July – Saturday 14 July 2018. This meeting of approximately 265 members of the Uniting Church in Australia meets for six days every three years to discuss the direction and priorities of the Uniting Church. The outcome is a series of decisions that guide the life of the Church and its advocacy over the following three years.

The Victoria/Tasmania Synod office is currently seeking Melbourne based Uniting Church congregation members who would like to be a part of this important event in the life of the Church in a volunteer capacity.

Volunteers will not only provide essential practical and logistical assistance to members but also provide a friendly welcome particularly to those travelling from interstate and overseas.
