## **GROWING INTERGENERATIONAL MINISTRY**

## **THRIVING MINISTRY LEADERSHIP**

Andrew McDonough, best known as the author and illustrator of the *Lost Sheep* books, is coming to Victoria! Drawing on his wide experience in ministry, including working as a pastor amongst the homeless, supporting people struggling with addictions and advocating for refugees, Andrew will be facilitating a series of workshops entitled ***Thriving Ministry Leadership: lessons from a duck, an echidna and a caterpillar***. Focused on those in ministry leadership, such as ministers, deacons, pastors, chaplains, lay preachers, church council members and those with specific responsibility for children, young people and families, these sessions will be immensely inspiring, encouraging and practical. Andrew will also highlight his latest book - *Jesus was a refugee*.

The Yarra Yarra session will be on Sunday, 24<sup>th</sup> February at Surrey Hills, from 2:30pm, and the cost is \$20.
