PRESBYTERY NEWS

Presbytery Meetings

The first meeting of the Presbytery on Saturday 25th February at the Canterbury Balwyn Road Uniting Church was attended by about 70 people. The major item on the agenda was a segment led by the Moderator, Rev David Fotheringham, who introduced a discussion about the Synod Standing Committee's decision to establish a Synod-wide Strategic Planning Task Group as a joint project of Presbyteries and the Synod to work towards the preparation and articulation of a common Strategic Plan. Input from our Presbytery will assist initially in the preparation of Terms of Reference for the Task Group, which will report to the 2023 Synod meeting in November. Thank you to all who contributed and made comments.

The meeting also provided endorsement for a proposal that Chris Waddell be regarded as ready for ordination once he has completed his studies and accepted a call.


Annual Reporting for Ministers

In his report to the Presbytery the Presbytery Minister Ministry, Ray McCluskey, outlined the way in which the Presbytery will introduce a variety of requirements related to the pastoral care of Ministers. These include Supervision, Professional Development, Working with Children and Safe Church, and annual reporting of leave.



This will be through an online portal, and will ensure that accurate records are available to the Minister, the Church Council, the Presbytery and the Synod (including the Central Payroll Service).
