CPE Program – Semester 2



SYNOD 2025: Sat 30 Aug – Tues 2 Sep 2025

The 18th Meeting of the Synod of Victoria and Tasmania meeting will commence at 10am on **Saturday 30th August 2025** and conclude by 4pm on Tuesday 2nd September 2025 and will be held at Box Hill Town Hall, 1022 Whitehorse Road, Box Hill.

It will open with the installation of our new Moderator, **Rev Salesi Faupula**; and feature Bible studies and theological reflection – framed by the Synod meeting theme: *Pilgrims of the Spirit*, reporting from key Synod bodies, and opportunities for reflecting on, and looking forward for the Synod's mission as part of the UCA across Victoria and Tasmania.

Although we are still a number of months away from the Synod meeting, Synod are asking presbyteries to **begin thinking about Synod membership and encouraging discussions regarding Synod membership and any proposals for the Synod meeting**, within our presbytery and congregations as early as possible.

Presbytery's process has changed, Minister's within the Presbytery of Yarra Yarra are no longer automatically made Synod Members by the Presbytery, instead **Ministers will need to notify Presbytery Office of their interest in nominating for Synod Membership.**

Centenary of Workship Ivanhoe UC – October 2025

The Ivanhoe congregation was established in 1890, with the current building erected in 1925, and the first service held on October 24 of that year.

Members at Ivanhoe are excited about the up and coming 100 years of worship in this building and extend a warm invitation to representatives of Presbytery to join in for what should be a wonderful celebration.

To commemorate the centenary of worship in this building, a day of celebrations will be held on **October 26 2025**.

Lowery Citation console theatre organ–Free

Labelled above the keyboard as a Lowery symphonizer

Dimensions: Height: 1.1 m high.

Width: 1.35 m wide x 80 cm from the back of the organ to the front of the keyboard. Depth from front to back: With pedals and seat 1.20 m

It is approximately 30 to 40 years old and is in excellent working condition.

Would require a van or small truck to move.

The seat is worn by exposure to passing traffic, but the organ body is in very good condition.
