Ministers' Annual Leave Portal

There has always been a requirement to complete Leave Forms for Ministers wishing to take annual leave. These need to be recorded by the Church Council of the Congregation, the Presbytery, and forwarded to the Synod Payroll Office. An Online Leave Portal has been implemented to allow a Church Council Secretary or Treasurer to prepare the leave form online, and to have it automatically submitted to the Presbytery and Synod. Copies are also sent to the Church Council and the Minister.



This free program will run weekly from **Thursday, 16 October to late November**, 11 am - 12.30 pm. Hosted at Elm St Mission in Bayswater, the program is for women who support someone with mental health challenges, disability, chronic conditions or age-related needs.



Caring for others brings rewards and challenges, and it's important that carers can be part of a group where they feel safe to share their thoughts, express themselves and have some fun.
